(Carson, CA) –Ranging from socially engaged ad campaigns to visual branding, the creative diversity and talent of 37 graduating seniors from the California State University, Dominguez Hills Art and Design Department will be on full display in the one-day pop-up exhibit, “Vantage Point: 2018 Senior Design Showcase” (May 3).

As part of the Art and Design Department’s curriculum, each student is required to create an exhibition of selected works produced during their studies at the university. “Vantage Point” is the end result of these efforts. The designers must also design and publish a website documenting their works of art, and participate in a portfolio review before a panel of professors and commercial and graphic artists. Students taking the design option must also create a professional portfolio, which is displayed in a series of events as a component of the senior design showcase.

The “Vantage Point: 2018 Senior Design Showcase” pop-up exhibit and design social will take place Thursday, May 3 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. This showcase takes place in the CSUDH University Art Gallery and is free and open to the public.
